2. Heard Mr. S.K. Acharya, learned counsel for the petitioner and Mr. P.P. Mohanty, learned Additional Government Advocate for the State.

3. The petitioner has filed this writ petition seeking to set aside the rejection of the bid of the petitioner dated 17.09.2022 vide Annexure-2 and to direct the Opposite Party no.3 to consider the petitioner for the purpose of further participation in the financial bid stage.
