1. This matter is taken up through hybrid mode.
2. Heard learned counsel for the petitioner, learned counsel for the State and learned counsel for the informant.
3. Learned counsel Ms. A. Sahoo & Associates have entered appearance on behalf of the informant/victim. Vakalatnama filed on behalf of the informant/victim is taken on record. Name of Ms. A. Sahoo & Associates be reflected in the file, in the cause list as well as in the CMS of this Court.
4. The petitioner is an accused in connection with G.R. Case No.81 of 2022, pending in the Court of learned J.M.F.C., Khandapada, arising out of Khandapada P.S. Case No.84 of 2022, for alleged commission of offences under Sections 294/323/324/341/307/354/506/326/34 of IPC read with Section 25/27 of Arms Act.

5. Being aggrieved by the rejection of his application for bail U/s.439 Cr.P.C. by the learned Assistant Sessions Judge, Khandapada, by order dated 28.09.2022 in the aforementioned case, the present BLAPL has been filed.

6. Perused the statement of the injured Susanta Kumar Sahoo, attributing the overt act to one Tikina @ Santosh Nayak.

Considering the statement of the injured and release of the co-accused Sudar @ Sudarsan Nayak by this Court by order dated 22.09.2022 in BLAPL No.3837 of 2022 and filing of charge-sheet, this Court directs the petitioner to be released on bail on such terms to be fixed by the Court in seisin over the matter.

8. Accordingly, the BLAPL stands disposed of.
