1. This matter is taken up through hybrid mode.
2. Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned counsel for the State.
3. The petitioner is an accused in connection with G.R. Case No.29(A) of 2022, pending in the Court of learned J.M.F.C., Nimapara, arising out of Kakatpur P.S. No.06 of 2022, for alleged commission of offences under Sections 376(2)(n)/417/34 of IPC.
