3. The petitioner has filed this writ petition seeking direction to opposite parties no.3 & 4 to refix his pay in the 1st, 2nd and 3rd RACP from 29.10.1986, 29.10.1996 and 29.10.2006 and grant actual financial benefit in his favour from 01.01.2013.
4. In course of hearing, learned counsel for the petitioner states that highlighting the grievances, the petitioner has made representation to opposite party no.3 vide Annexure-5 and the same may be directed to be considered within a stipulated time, to which learned State Counsel has no objection.
