This matter is taken up through hybrid mode.

2. The petitioner has filed this writ petition seeking to quash the order dated 07.05.2010 as at Annexure-6 so far as his appointment as NWM under work charge establishment is concerned, and to issue direction to the opposite parties to pay the scale of pay of Rs.5200/- to Rs.20200/- with grade pay of Rs.1900/- from the date of his appointment under Annexure-6 as well as to pay the differential arrear salary within a stipulated time.

3. In course of hearing, learned counsel for the petitioner states that the petitioner has already made representation before opposite party no.2 vide Annexure-7, and the same may be directed to be disposed of within a stipulated time taking into consideration Annexure-8 within a stipulated time, to which learned State Counsel has raised no objection.

4. As agreed by learned counsel for the parties, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, this writ petition stands disposed of directing opposite party no.2 to

consider the representation filed by the petitioner under Annexure-11 taking into consideration Annexure-8 by passing a reasoned and speaking order as expeditiously as possible, preferably within a period of three months from the date of receipt of the certified copy of this order.
