1. Heard learned counsel for the Petitioner and learned counsel for the State.
 2. This is an application for bail U/s.438 Cr.P.C. filed by the Petitioner in apprehension of arrest for his alleged involvement in the offences under Section 365 of IPC.
 3. Learned counsel for the State submits to have obtained the up-to-date case diary including the statement of the victim recorded U/s. 164 Cr.P.C it can very well be said that regard being had to the facts and circumstances, the allegations the victim lady who is of considerable age had enough scope to visualize the consequence of the relationship in such of the matter.
 4. Keeping in view the submission of the parties, the nature of allegations as emerged from the materials on record, the circumstances appearing, the seriousness and gravity of the

offences, while this court is not inclined to grant anticipatory bail, it is directed that in the event the Petitioner surrenders and moves for bail in connection with G.R Case No.323 of 2022 arising out of Loisingha P.S. Case No.330 of 2022 pending in the court of learned J.M.F.C., Loisingha within a period of three weeks' hence and moves for bail, he shall be released on such terms and conditions as would be deemed just and proper by the said court with further conditions that he shall appear in person before the court below on each date of posting of the case unless specifically exempted by the court concerned. The Petitioner, however, shall also not intimidate the victim and take any such step to sabotage her cause. Violation of these conditions shall entail cancellation of the bail automatically.

5. The ABLAPL is disposed of accordingly.
