- 01.** 1. This matter is taken up through Hybrid Arrangement (Virtual/Physical) Mode.
2. Heard Mr. B. Barik, learned counsel for the Petitioner and Mr. Ch. S. Mishra, learned AGA appearing for the Opp. Parties.
3. Even though the present writ Petition has been filed with a prayer to direct the Opp. Parties to regularize the services of the Petitioner, but no document has been annexed to the writ Petition reflecting that the Petitioner has approached the Authority seeking such regularization of his services.
4. In that view of the matter this Court while disposing of the writ Petition, permits the Petitioner to make appropriate application in that regard before the O.P. No. 2.
