This matter is taken up through hybrid mode.

2. The petitioner has filed this writ petition seeking direction to the opposite parties to provide subsistence allowances from the date of his suspension i.e., 02.02.2018 and further seeks direction to reinstate him by setting aside the suspension.

In course of hearing, learned counsel for the petitioner states that highlighting the grievances, the petitioner has made representation to the opposite party no.2 vide Annexure-3 and the same may be directed to be disposed of within a stipulated time, to which learned State Counsel has raised no objection.

As agreed to by learned counsel for the parties, however, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, this writ petition stands disposed of directing opposite party no.2 to consider the representation filed by the petitioner vide Annexure-3, and pass appropriate order in accordance with law within a period of three months from the date of production/communication of certified copy of this order.
