It is therefore prayed that this Hon'ble Court would graciously be pleased to admit this writ application and to issue rule Nisi directing the Opp.parties to show cause as to why the Army Group Insurance claim shall not be released in favour of the petitioner and if the opp.parties fail to show cause or show insufficient cause the said rule be made absolute.”
