1. This matter is taken up through Hybrid Arrangement (Virtual/Physical Mode).
 2. Heard learned counsel for the petitioners and learned Additional Standing Counsel for the State.
 3. This is an application under Section 438, Cr.P.C. filed by the petitioners for anticipatory bail.
 4. The petitioners are seeking pre-arrest bail in connection with G.R. Case No.469 of 2022, arising out of Umerkote P.S. Case No.341 of 2022 pending in the court of learned J.M.F.C., Umerkote for commission of offence punishable under Sections 498-A/323/294/506/34, I.P.C. read with Section 4 of the D.P. Act.
 5. Considering the nature of allegation, gravity of offence and the fact of the case, I am not inclined to grant anticipatory bail to the petitioners. However, it is directed that in the event the petitioners surrender and move an application for bail before the learned court in seisin over the matter within a period of three weeks from today in the aforesaid case, they shall be released on bail on such terms and

conditions as would be deemed just and proper with further conditions that :-

- I. Petitioners shall not harass, torture, threaten or terrorize the informant and his/her family members in any manner whatsoever while on bail;
- II. he shall not indulge in similar nature of criminal activities while on bail; and
- III. he shall also lookafter well being by the petitioner and shall provide a sum of Rs.2,000/- (rupees two thousand) per month for sustenance of the informant-wife.

Violation of any of the terms and conditions shall entail cancellation of bail.

6. Accordingly, the ABLAPL is disposed of.
