2. Heard Mr. R.K. Das, learned counsel for the Petitioner.
3. This is an application filed by the petitioner seeking for transfer of T.R. Case No. 02 of 2021 filed under Sec. 20(B)II(C) and 29 of the NDPS Act, pending before the learned ADJ –cum- Special Judge, Gunupur, Rayagada to the Court of learned Special Judge, Sambalpur.
