The petitioner has filed this writ petition seeking to quash the order of transfer issued at Annexure-4 in respect of the petitioner and order vide letter No.1555 dated 01.08.2018 under Annexure-10 and further to issue direction to the opposite parties to permit the petitioner to continue at his previous place of working i.e. office of the RTO, Nabarangpur.

In course of hearing, learned counsel for the petitioner states that highlighting the grievances, the petitioner has made representation to opposite party no.1 vide Annexure-11 and the same may be directed to be considered and disposed of within a stipulated time, to which learned State Counsel has no objection.
