1. This matter is taken up through Hybrid Arrangement (Virtual /Physical Mode).
2. Heard learned counsel for the Petitioner and learned Additional Standing Counsel.
3. The Petitioner has filed the present writ application with the following prayer:

“ The Petitioners, therefore prays that the Hon’ble Court may kindly be pleased to admit the writ petition and to issue a “RULE NISI” to the Opp.Parties to show cause as to;

- i) Why the Opposite Parties will not be directed to run the primary school at present location by providing better environment of education like building and other facilities in the interest of Khajurialua people for running Khajurialua Primary School at the same location which was directed to closed don’t show cause or shows any sufficient cause then the rule to be made absolutely by issuing opposite parties/ writ(s)/orders(s) /direction(s) as the circumstances justified.”

4. In course of hearing of the writ application, learned counsel for the Petitioner submits that the Petitioner ventilating his grievance has

submitted representation before the Collector, Jajpur, Opposite Party No.3 on 19.05.2022 under Annexure-6 series. It is also submitted by the learned counsel for the Petitioner that the said representation is pending as of now. It is also submitted by the learned counsel for the Petitioner that a direction be issued to the Opposite Party No.3 to consider the representation of the Petitioner under Annexure-6 series within a stipulated period of time.

5. Learned Additional Standing Counsel submits that he has no objection if the representation of the Petitioner is considered by the Opposite Party No.3 which is stated to be pending, in accordance with law within a stipulated period of time.

6. Considering the limited nature of grievance of the Petitioner, the writ application is disposed of at the stage of admission with a direction to the Opposite Party no.3 to consider the representation of the Petitioner under Annexure-6 series in accordance with law within a period of three months from the date of production of certified copy of this order. The Opposite Party No.3 shall do well to dispose of the representation of the Petitioner under Annexure-6 series by passing a speaking and reasoned order.

7. With the aforesaid observation, the writ application stands disposed of.

8. Issue urgent certified copy of this order as per Rules.
