2. Heard learned counsel for the Appellant and learned Additional Standing Counsel for the State.
3. The appellant is in custody since 09.05.2022 in connection with Talachua Marine P.S. Case No. 53 of 2019 corresponding to T.R. Case No. 97 of 2019 pending in the Court of learned Special Judge, Kendrapara for the alleged commission of the offence under Sections- 341/294/323/307/354/506/34 of the I.P.C read with Section- 3(1)(r)(s)/ 3 (v)(a) of the SC & ST (POA) Act, 1989.
