1. This matter is taken up through Hybrid Arrangement (Virtual/Physical) Mode.

2. Heard learned counsel for the Petitioner and learned counsel for the Opposite Parties.

3. The Petitioner has filed the present Writ Petition with the following prayer:-

“ In view of the facts stated in para 6 above, your Lordships may be pleased to-

i) To direct the respondents to approve the post fo Hindi Teacher and release the salary from the date of joining.

ii) To direct the respondents to release the arrear salary as well as service benefits within a stipulated period.

iii) To pass such other order/orders as this Hon’ble Tribunal may deems fit and proper.”

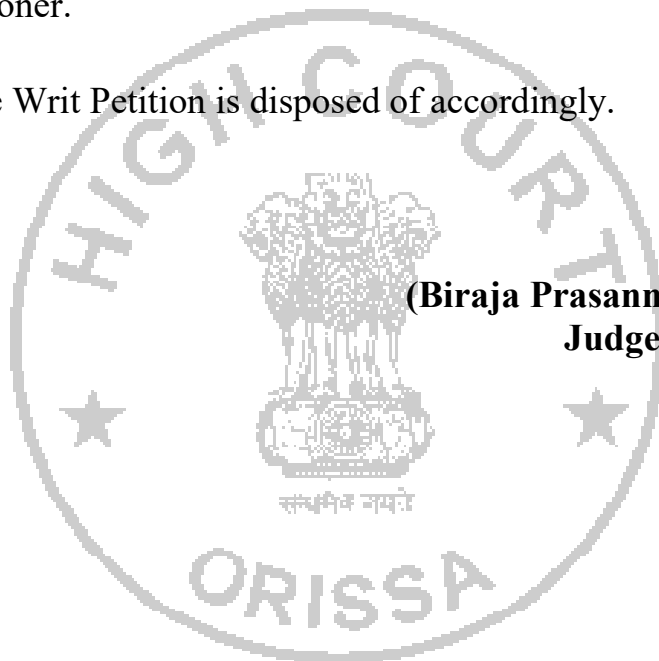
4. Learned counsel for the Petitioner further submits that through highlighting her grievances, the petitioner has filed a representation on 05.01.2015 at Annexure-11 to the Writ Petition

before the O.P. No.1, but till date nothing has been done in the matter. In such background, he prays that a direction be issued to Opposite Party No.1 to take a decision on the above noted petition within a specific time period.

4. Considering the submissions made and without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, this Court directs Opposite Party No.1 to take a decision on the above noted petition in accordance with law within a period of three months from the date of receipt of this order and communicate the result of such exercise to the petitioner.

5. The Writ Petition is disposed of accordingly.
