This matter is taken up through hybrid mode.

2. The petitioners have filed this writ petition seeking direction to the opposite party no.2 to take strong action to free the illegal encroachment as per the schedule, which is situated in front of the petitioner's residential and agricultural land, within a stipulated time.

In course of hearing, learned counsel for the petitioners states that highlighting the grievances, the petitioners have made representation to the opposite party no.2 vide Annexure-3 and the same may be directed to be disposed of within a stipulated time, to which learned State Counsel has raised no objection.

As agreed to by learned counsel for the parties, however, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, this writ petition stands disposed of directing the opposite party no.2 to consider the representation filed by the petitioners vide Annexure-3, and pass appropriate order in accordance with law within a period of three months from the date of production of certified copy of this order.
