01. 1. This matter is taken up through Hybrid Arrangement (Virtual /Physical Mode).
2. Heard learned counsel for the Petitioners, learned Addl. Standing Counsel for the State. Perused the records.
3. This is an application under Section 438, Cr.P.C. filed by the Petitioners for anticipatory bail, involving offence punishable under Sections 452, 294, 323, 354, 325, 379, 506/34 of the Indian Penal Code.
4. Considering the seriousness of the allegation, gravity of the offence and the facts of the case, although I am not inclined to grant anticipatory bail to the Petitioners, however it is observed that, in the event the Petitioners surrender and move for bail before the learned J.M.F.C., Chandbali in G.R.Case No.782 of 2022 arising out of Bansada P.S.Case No.334 of 2022, they shall be released on bail on such terms and conditions as the learned Magistrate may deem just

and proper in the facts and circumstances of the case, but subject to verification of Injury Report.

5. The ABLAPL is disposed of accordingly.
