This matter is taken up through hybrid mode.

2. The petitioner has filed this writ petition seeking to quash the order dated 01.09.2016 under Annexure-23 and to issue direction that the Government direction given in the letter under Annexure-19 be given full force by treating the entire training period from 29.11.2014 till completion of the training dated 22.06.2015 and joining in the previous post on dated 23.06.2015 as continuity in service.

3. In course of hearing, learned counsel for the petitioner states that highlighting the grievances, the petitioner has made representation to the opposite party no.3 vide Annexure-25 and the same may be directed to be disposed of within a stipulated time taking into consideration Annexure-10, to which learned State Counsel has raised no objection.

4. As agreed to by learned counsel for the parties, however, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, this writ petition stands disposed of directing the opposite party no.3 to consider the representation filed by the petitioner vide Annexure-25, taking into consideration Annexure-10, and pass appropriate order in accordance with law within a period of three months from the date of production of certified copy of this order.
