3. The present Writ Petition has been filed with the following prayer:-

“Under the circumstances, it is prayed that the Hon’ ble Court may be pleased to Admit the writ petition. Call for the records. After hearing both sides this Hon’ble Court maybe pleased to issue a writ in nature of mandamus or any appropriate writ / writs directing the Opp. Party No.2 to grant extension of contract for further period of two years in respect of two wheeler motor cycles stand No.3, Cuttack”.

In course of hearing, learned counsel for the Petitioner states that highlighting the grievances, the Petitioner has made a representation to Opposite Party No.2 vide Annexure-2 and the same may be directed to be considered within a stipulated time, to which learned Counsel for the State has no objection.
