“Therefore, it is prayed that the Hon’ble Court may be graciously pleased to admit the Writ Application, issue rule NISI in the nature of Writ of mandamus or any other Writ/Writs as deem fit and direct, the Tahasildar, Biswanathpur, (Lanjigarh) to consider the Annexure-3 Dt. 26.10.2021 and settle the land in favour of the petitioner as a landless person, within a particular period.
