2. Heard learned counsel for the parties.

3. The petitioners have filed this writ petition seeking direction to the opposite parties to revalidate the transit permit issued by them for transportation of the minerals vide Annexure-12 within a stipulated period.

In course of hearing, learned counsel for the petitioners states that the petitioner-company has already made representation before opposite party no.2-Deputy Director of Mines, Keonjhar vide Annexure-12, and the same may be directed to be disposed of within a stipulated time, to which learned Additional Government Advocate has no objection.
