This matter is taken up through hybrid mode.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner undertakes to remove the defect within three days.
3. The petitioner has filed this writ petition seeking direction to opposite parties to release the arrear salary of the petitioner for the period from March 1986 to June, 1994 as per the bill submitted by the Headmaster under Annexure-3 series.
4. In course of hearing, learned counsel for the petitioner states that highlighting the grievance, the petitioner has made representation to the opposite party no.3 vide Annexure-3 series and direction be given to consider and dispose of the same within a stipulated time, to which learned Standing Counsel for School & Mass Education Department has no objection.
