2. Heard Mr. I.A. Acharya, learned Counsel appearing for the petitioner and Mr. P.P. Mohanty, learned Addl. Government Advocate.

3. The petitioner has filed this writ petition seeking direction to opposite party no.1 to dispose of the applications dated 23.05.2015 and 07.11.2017 under Annexures-13 and 22 for revival of the mining lease within a stipulated period.

In course of hearing, learned counsel for the petitioner states that the petitioner has already made representation before the Opposite Party no.1 vide Annexure-22, and the same may be directed to be disposed of within a stipulated time, to which learned Addl. Government Advocate has raised no objection.
