02. 1. This matter is taken up through Hybrid Arrangement (Virtual /Physical Mode).

Learned counsel for the petitioner is permitted to make necessary corrections in the cause title of the bail in Court today.

2. Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned counsel for the State.

3. It is submitted by learned counsel for the petitioner that the ABLAPL No.13665 of 2022 was disposed of by order dated 21.10.2022 but in 2<sup>nd</sup> line of the paragraph-7 of the said order, the case number has been wrongly mentioned as “Special Case No.25 of 2022” instead of “Special Case No.27 of 2022”, which mistake also appears in the cause title of the bail application. Hence, modification has been prayed for.

4. Accordingly, it is directed that in 2<sup>nd</sup> line of the paragraph-7 of

the order dated 21.10.2022 it be mentioned as “Special Case No.27 of 2022” in place of “Special Case No.25 of 2022”, rest part of the order shall remain intact.

5. Four weeks’ further time from today is extended for the petitioner to surrender before the learned court below, vide order dated 14.10.2022 passed in ABLAPL No.13665 of 2022, but subject to depositing cost of Rs.500/- (Rupees five hundred) in the Advocates’ Welfare Fund of Orissa High Court Bar Association within fifteen days and furnishing money receipt thereof in proof of deposit.

6. It is made clear that, if the cost is not deposited within the stipulated time, time extended for the petitioner to surrender shall stand revoked automatically.

7. The I.A is disposed of accordingly.
