1. This matter is taken up through Hybrid Mode.

2. Heard learned counsel for the Parties.

3. The Writ Petition has been filed with the following prayer:-

“(i) Direct the Respondent Nos.1 and 2 to consider the case of the applicant to the cadre of Sr. SES under 3% reservation quota for PH category of candidates w.e.f. 21.6.2014 along with service & financial benefits within a time stipulated as fixed by this Hon’ble Tribunal”.

4. He further submits that through highlighting his grievances, the petitioner has filed a representation on 22.09.2014 at Annexure-6 to the Writ Petition before the opposite party No.1 but till date nothing has been done in the matter. In such background, he prays that a direction be issued to opposite party no.1 to take a decision on the above noted petition within a specific time period.

5. Considering the submissions made and without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, this Court directs opposite party No.1 to take a decision on the above noted petition in accordance with law within a period of two months from the date of production of certified copy of this order and communicate the result of such exercise to the petitioners.

6. The Writ Petition is disposed of accordingly.
