- 1.** This matter is taken up through Hybrid Mode.
- 2.** Heard learned counsel for the Parties.
- 3.** The Writ Petition has been filed with the following prayer:-

“(i) The Hon’ble Tribunal graciously be pleased to declare Para-2 & 3 of the Resolution dtd.04.12.2013 of the Govt. in School & Mass Education Department being contradictory benefits extended in Para-7 of the same Resolution dtd.04.12.2013 to only untrained and trained SC, ST and PH Ganasikhyak with six years service from the date of engagement as Ganasikhyak as illegal, arbitrary and un-reasonable and further it violates Art-14 & 16 of the Constitution of India”.

- 4.** He further submits that through highlighting his grievances, the petitioner has filed a representation on 02.02.2014 at Annexure-6 to the Writ Petition before the opposite party No.1 but till date nothing has been done in the matter. In such background, he prays that a direction be issued to opposite party no.1 to take a

decision on the above noted petition within a specific time period.

5. Considering the submissions made and without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, this Court directs opposite party No.1 to take a decision on the above noted petition in accordance with law within a period of two months from the date of production of certified copy of this order and communicate the result of such exercise to the petitioners.

6. The Writ Petition is disposed of accordingly.
