1. This matter is taken up through hybrid mode.
 2. The writ petition has been registered before this Court on 28.12.2022 after the Original Application was transferred upon abolition of the learned Odisha Administrative Tribunal, Cuttack.
 3. On perusal of the available order sheets of the learned Tribunal it is indicated that notices were issued on 11.5.2016 directing to file counter within four weeks and rejoinder within two weeks. The matter was never taken up/pursued after 22.8.2016.
 4. The O.A. was filed in the year 2016 by the petitioner stating herself to be “first wife” of the deceased employee Mr. Biswanath Muduli who retired from service as Headmaster and she was getting pension vide Pension Payment Order No. 66514 dated 10/2009.
 5. Learned counsel for petitioner submits that he has no up-to-date instruction to pursue the matter on behalf of the petitioner at present.

6. Learned Standing Counsel submits that he has no up-to-date instruction in the matter.

7. Having heard learned counsel for the parties, the writ petition is disposed of granting liberty to revive the petition within sixty days for any surviving cause of action.
