redressed.

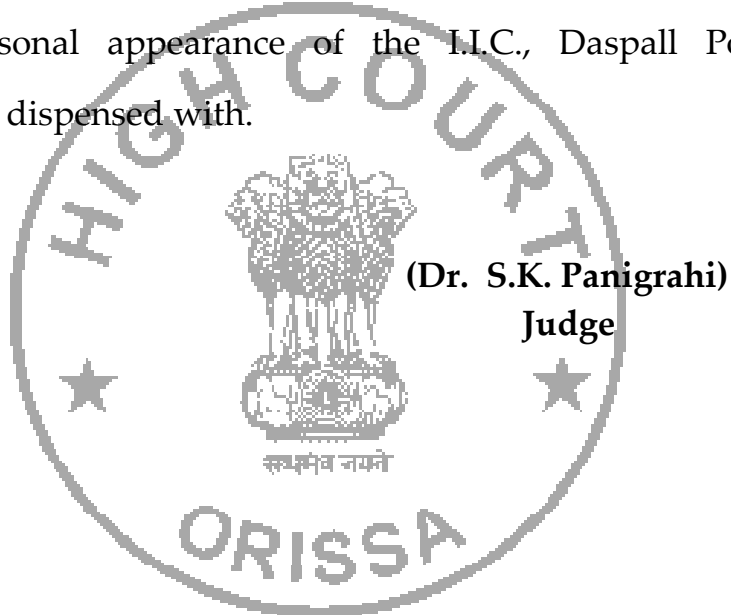
6. Mr. Sahoo undertakes that he will complete the investigation in connection with the above noted P.S. Case within the reasonable time.
