1. 1. This matter is taken up through Hybrid Mode.
2. Heard learned counsel for the Petitioner.
3. The petitioner has filed this writ petition with the following prayer:-

“ to direct the respondents especially Respondent No.4 to consider the representation of the applicant for the grant of family pension to her, being the disabled unmarried daughter/legal heir of the deceased Govt. servant i.e. her deceased father with immediate effect to save her life.”
