2. Defect pointed out by S.R. be removed within three days.
3. The petitioners have filed this writ petition seeking direction to the opposite parties to evict opposite party no.4 from Plot No. 529 under Khata No. 195 of Mouza-Banabiharipur under Rajnagar Tahasil.

In course of hearing, learned counsel for the petitioners states that highlighting the grievance, the petitioners have made representation to the opposite party no.3 vide Annexure-3 and direction may be given to consider and dispose of the same, within a stipulated time, to which learned Counsel for State has no objection.
