1. This matter is taken up by virtual/physical mode.
 2. The Original Application No.1201 of 2014 was filed before the Odisha Administrative Tribunal, Bhubaneswar. After its abolition, the same has been transferred to this Court which is renumbered as WPC (OA) No.1201 of 2014.
 3. Heard Mr. Pranaya Swain, learned counsel for the Petitioner Nos. 5 and 7 renumbered as Petitioner Nos. 1 and 2 respectively and Mr. L. Samantaray, learned Addl. Govt. Advocate.
 4. The Petitioners working as pump operators (Khalasi) have challenged the order dated 14.05.2014 passed by the Block Development Officer, Nayagarh whereby they are directed to be disengaged in view of Panchayati Raj Department letter No. 11017-17-CFC-20-1001/PR, dtd. 12/04/2013.
