This matter is taken up through hybrid mode.

2. The petitioner has filed this writ petition seeking direction to the opposite party no.2 to take appropriate steps on the letter of opposite party no.1 vide Annexure-1 with regard to his promotion from MPHWS (M) to MPHS (M) from the date of promotion of his juniors and pay the amount by fixing the pension on the promotional scale along with differential arrear amount within a stipulated time.

3. In course of hearing, learned counsel for the petitioner states that highlighting the grievances, the petitioner has made representation to the opposite party no.2 vide Annexure-5 and the same may be directed to be disposed of within a stipulated time, to which learned State Counsel has raised no objection.

4. As agreed to by learned counsel for the parties, however, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, this writ petition stands disposed of directing opposite party no.2 to consider the representation filed by the petitioner vide Annexure-5, and pass appropriate order in accordance with law within a period of three months from the date of production/communication of certified copy of this order.
