1. This matter is taken up through Hybrid Mode.
2. Heard learned counsel for the parties.
3. The present Writ Petition has been filed with the following prayer:

*“(i) quash the impugned Notification No.6871/H dated 2.4.2015 in Annexure-3 in so far as applicant is concerned by holding the same as bad, illegal and passed in malafide and capricious exercise of powers in the hands of the respondent No.1 and thereby*

*(ii) direct/order/command the respondents to allow the applicant to continue at SCB Medical College & Hospital, Cuttack in her present place of posting until disposal of O.A. No.656 (C) /2009 and batch and pass such other order(s) as would be deemed fit and proper in the facts and circumstances of the case.”*

4. Considering the nature of prayer made in the Writ Petition, the Petitioner is permitted to make a fresh representation before Opp. party No.1 within a period of three weeks days from today.

5. It is observed that if such a representation is filed by the Petitioner ventilating his grievances, the same shall be

considered by Opp. party No.1 in accordance with law within a period of three months from the date of receipt of such representation. The order so passed by Opp. Party No.1 be communicated to the Petitioner also.

**6.** With the aforesaid observation and direction, the Writ Petition is disposed of.
