1. Heard the submission of learned counsel for Petitioner.
2. There is a serious allegation of abrupt seizure of the shop room no.8. On the premises of loss of livelihood for such conduct of the public authority the Petitioner vide Annexure-3 has already made a request to the District Magistrate-cum-Collector, Angul. Learned counsel for the Petitioner submits that on the asking of the Collector, the representation at Annexure-3 has been handed over to the Secretary of the Collector.

Considering that the matter is pending before the District Magistrate-cum-Collector, Angul, this Court to avoid any further loss of time, directs the District Magistrate-cum-Collector, Angul to show outcome on the grievance of the Petitioner vide Annexure-3, by completing the entire exercise within a period of one month from the date of communication of a certified copy of this order along with a

copy of the writ petition by the Petitioner and if necessary involving the Petitioner as well as the persons likely to be affected.

4. The Writ Petition stands disposed of with the above order.
