1. 1. This matter is taken up through Hybrid Mode.
2. Heard learned counsel for the parties.
3. The present Writ Petition has been filed with the following prayer:

“(i) quash the impugned Notification No.6871/H dated 2.4.2015 in Annexure-2 in so far as applicant is concerned and the applicant may be allowed to continue as Asst. Surgeon in SCB Medical College & Hospital, Cuttack without any interference by the Respondents.”

4. Considering the nature of prayer made in the Writ Petition, the Petitioner is permitted to make a fresh representation before Opp. party No.1 within a period of three weeks days from today.

5. It is observed that if such a representation is filed by the Petitioner ventilating his grievances, the same shall be considered by Opp. party No.1 in accordance with law within a period of three months from the date of receipt of such representation. The order so passed by Opp. Party No.1 be communicated to the Petitioner also.

6. With the aforesaid observation and direction, the Writ Petition is disposed of.
