3. The present Writ Petition has been filed with the following prayer:-

“It is therefore prayed that the Hon’ble Court may be graciously pleased to admit the Writ Application, Issue notice, rule NISI in the nature of mandamus or any other Writ/Writs as deem fit and proper, calling upon the Opp. Parties to direct the Opp. Party No.4 to consider the representation dtd.2.3.2022 under Annexure-6 and released the ex-gratia compensation in favour of the petitioners within a stipulated period”.

In course of hearing, learned counsel for the Petitioners states that highlighting their grievance, the Petitioners have made representation to Opposite Party No.4 vide Annexure-6 and the same may be directed to be considered within a stipulated time, to which learned Counsel for the State has no objection.
