01. 1. This matter is taken up through Hybrid Arrangement (Virtual/Physical) Mode.
2. Heard Mr. S. Behera, learned counsel for the Petitioner.
3. The Petitioner has filed this writ Petition with the following relief:-

“In view of the facts mentioned in Para-6 above, the applicant humbly prays that your Lordships would be graciously pleased to pass-

- 1. Order directing Respondent No. 1 to conclude the relevant disciplinary proceeding at Annexure-2 Series within a stipulated time limit, failing which the same shall be treated as quashed to meet the both ends of law and justice ab initio.*
- 2. Any other order/orders as deem fit and proper.*
