1. Heard learned counsel for the Parties.

In course of submission, it has been brought to the notice of this Court that for there is loss of File, the Authority is unable to proceed in the matter, which has also been intimated to the Petitioner through R.T.I. Application. In the event there is loss of File, nothing prevents the Competent Authority for re-construction of File taking help of the Petitioner.
