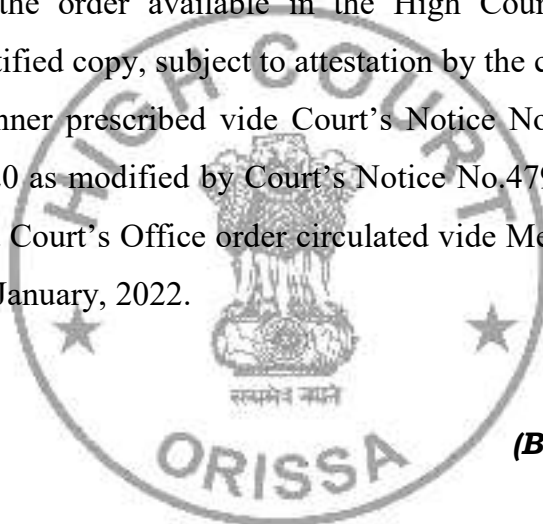
By granting any other relief(s) as found fit and proper in the facts and circumstances of the case;
