01. 1. This matter is taken up through Hybrid Arrangement (Virtual/Physical Mode).

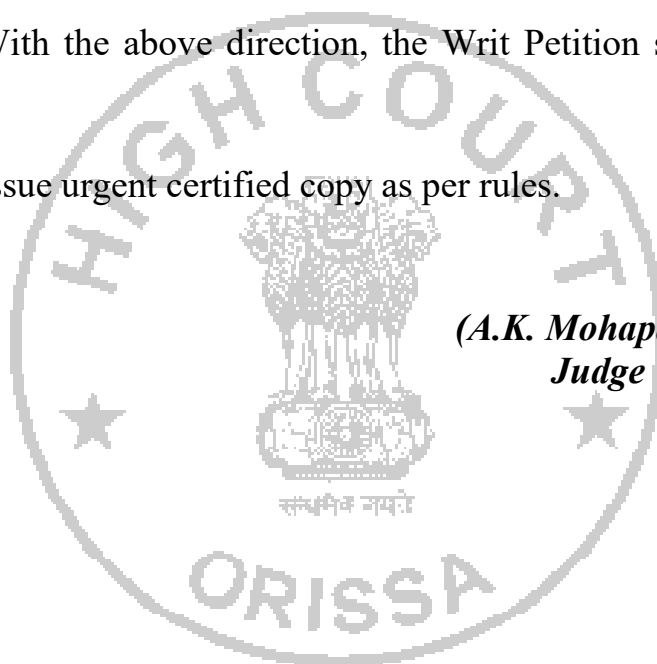
passed by the Joint Secretary to Government of Odisha, Home Department.
