1. This matter is taken up through virtual/physical mode.
2. The Original Application No.107 (C) of 2016 was filed before the State Administrative Tribunal, Cuttack Bench, Cuttack. After its abolition, the same has been transferred to this Court which is renumbered as WPC (OAPC) No.107 of 2016.
3. The Petitioner has come up before this Court with a grievance that though the Petitioner was put under suspension, no subsistence allowance has been extended to him.
