01. 1. This matter is taken up through video conferencing mode.
2. The Petitioner being in custody in connection with Kaliapani P.S. Case No.84 of 2021 corresponding to C.T. Case No.337 of 2021 on the file of the learned J.M.F.C., Sukhinda running for commission of offence under sections 326/307 of the IPC, has filed this application under section 439 of the Cr.P.C. for his release on bail.
3. Heard learned counsel for the Petitioner and learned counsel for the State.
4. Taking into account the submissions made; further keeping in view the materials on records as those stand against the Petitioner with other surrounding circumstances as also the period of detention of the Petitioner in custody and on going through the order passed by the learned Additional Session Judge; in the absence of any such impediment; it is directed that

the Petitioner be released on bail in the aforesaid case on such terms and conditions as deemed just and proper by the court in seisin of the case with further conditions that he will appear in person before the court in seisin of the case on each date of posting of the case till conclusion of the trial; and shall report before the Inspector-in-Charge of the concerned P.S. on every Monday in between 10.00 am to 2.00 pm for the next six months.

Violation of any of the above condition(s) shall entail cancellation of bail.

5. The BLAPL is accordingly disposed of.

As the restrictions due to resurgence of COVID-19 situation are continuing, learned Counsel for the parties may utilize a printout of the order available in the High Court's website, at par with certified copy, subject to attestation by the concerned Advocate, in the manner prescribed vide Court's Notice No.4587 dated 25th March, 2020 as modified by Court's Notice No.4798 dated 15th April, 2021 and Court's Office order circulated vide Memo Nos.514 and 515 dated 7th January, 2022.
