1. This matter is taken up through virtual mode.
2. Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned Additional Standing Counsel for the State.
3. Having regard to the nature of offences alleged and absence of any material to show that any steps were taken to apprehend the petitioner-accused during the investigation, the CRLMC is disposed of granting liberty to the petitioner to surrender before the court below within two weeks and move for bail. In such event, learned court below considering the above facts shall direct his release on bail on such terms and conditions as it may deem fit and proper.
4. The CRLMC is accordingly disposed of.
