1. This matter is taken up through virtual/physical mode.
 2. The Original Application No.159 of 2016 was filed before the State Administrative Tribunal, Odisha Bhubaneswar. After its abolition, the same has been transferred to this Court which is renumbered as WPC (OA) No.159 of 2016.
 3. Petition reveals that the Petitioner has approached this Court with a prayer to quash the order of deputation and order relieving, the Petitioner-applicant from Berhampur. It is also prayed for regularization during the intervening period.
