This matter is taken up through hybrid mode.

2. Heard learned counsel for the petitioner.
3. The petitioner has filed this writ petition seeking direction to opposite party No.3 to allow trained graduate scale of pay to the petitioner on attaining the age of 48 years with effect from 10.05.2014 instead of 10.05.2015 by modifying the order under Annexure-8.
4. In course of hearing, learned counsel for the petitioner states that highlighting the grievance, the petitioner has made representation to the opposite party no.3 vide Annexure-9 and direction may be given to consider and dispose of the same, within a stipulated time, to which learned Standing Counsel for School & Mass Education Department has no objection.
5. As agreed to by learned counsel for the parties, this Court without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, disposes of the writ petition directing the opposite party no.3 to take a decision on the representation filed by the petitioner vide Annexure-9 and pass appropriate order in accordance with law, within a period of three months from the date of production of certified copy of this order by the petitioner.
