1. Heard learned counsel for the Petitioners and learned counsel for the State.
 2. This is an application for bail U/s.438 Cr.P.C. filed by the Petitioners in anticipation of arrest for their alleged involvement in the offences U/s. 147/294/323/506/307/149 of IPC.
 3. It is submitted by the learned counsel for the petitioner that initially FIR was lodged by the complainant that resulted in the final report. However, in furtherance to the protest filed by the complainant, the case was registered against the Petitioners under Section 147/294/323/506/307/149 of IPC. The learned counsel further submitted that there is a deliberate harassment to the Petitioners and may be considered for bail.

4. Keeping in view the submission of the parties and having gone through the nature of allegations as emerged from the materials on record, and further the circumstances appearing, the seriousness and gravity of the offences, it is directed that in the event the Petitioners surrender and move for bail arising out of ICC No.04 of 2022 pending in the court of learned J.M.F.C., Khariar within a period of three weeks' hence, they shall be admitted to bail on such terms and conditions as would be deemed just and proper by the said court with further conditions that the Petitioners shall appear in person before the learned court below on each date of posting of the case and shall appear before the I.O. / I.I.C. of the concerned P.S. once in a week on such date and time fixed by the I.O. / I.I.C. for a period of six months or till the submission of final Form.

5. The ABLAPL is disposed of accordingly.
