This matter is taken up through hybrid mode.

2. Heard learned counsel for the parties.
3. The petitioner has filed this writ petition seeking direction to the opposite parties to declare the result of walk-in-interview dated 29.08.2022 and cancel the walk-in-interview dated 06.09.2022 based on wrong procedures and career mark as per Annexure-3.

In course of hearing, learned counsel for the petitioner states that highlighting the grievance, the petitioner has made representation to the opposite party no.2 vide Annexure-2 and direction may be given to consider and dispose of the same within a stipulated time, to which learned Standing Counsel for the School & Mass Education Department has no objection.
