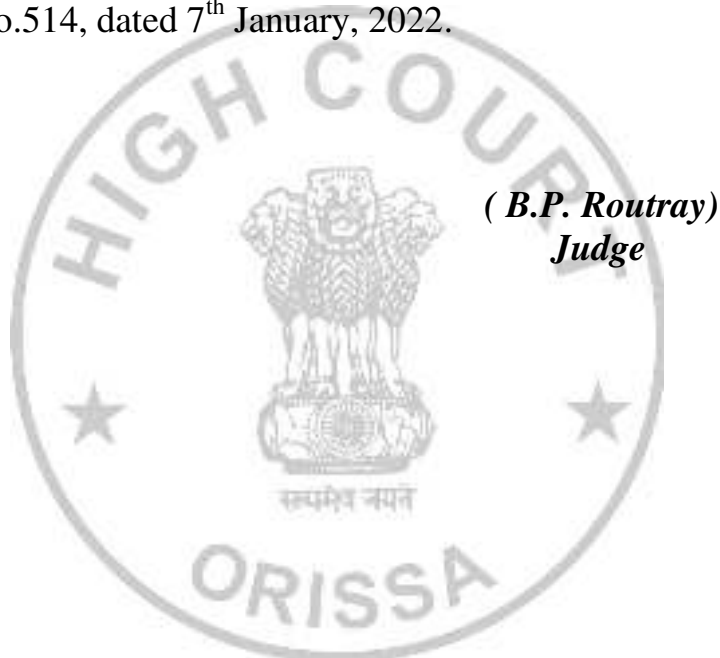

1. This matter is taken up through video conferencing.
 2. This is an application under Sec.439 Cr.P.C. for bail and the offences alleged are under Secs.395/397, I.P.C. and Secs.25/27 of the Arms Act.
 3. Heard Mr. L. Mahapatra, learned counsel for the Petitioner as well as Mr. S.S. Mohapatra, learned A.S.C. for the State-Opposite Party.
 4. The allegations are relating to looting of cash from the ATM vehicle to the tune of Rs.1,29,00,000/- by assaulting the armed guard.
 5. Upon hearing both the parties, I am not inclined to release the Petitioner on bail. Accordingly, the prayer for bail is rejected.

6. The BLAPL is dismissed.
