This matter is taken up through hybrid mode.

2. The petitioner has filed this writ petition seeking direction to the opposite parties not to evict the petitioner from her place of livelihood/shop, which is only source of income without following due procedure of law.

3. In course of hearing, learned counsel for the petitioner states that highlighting the grievances, the petitioner has made representation to the opposite party no.1 vide Annexure-2 and the same may be directed to be disposed of within a stipulated time.

4. Considering the limited nature of grievance, however, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, this writ petition stands disposed of directing the opposite party no.1 to consider the representation filed by the petitioner vide Annexure-2, and pass appropriate order in accordance with law within a period of three months from the date of production of certified copy of this order.
