01. 1. This matter is taken up through video conferencing mode.
2. The Petitioners being in custody in connection with Baunsuni P.S. Case No.145 of 2021 corresponding to Special Case (NDPS) No.54 of 2021 on the file of learned Special Judge, Boudh running for commission of offence under section 20(b)(ii)(B) of the NDPS Act, have filed this application under section 439 of the Cr.P.C. for their release on bail.
3. Heard learned counsel for the Petitioners and learned counsel for the State.
4. Taking into account the submissions made; further keeping in view the materials on records and the quantity of contraband ganja said to have been seized as those stand against the Petitioners with other surrounding circumstances

including the period of detention of the Petitioners in custody and on going through the order passed by the learned Special Judge; in the absence of any such impediment; it is directed that the Petitioners be released on bail in the aforesaid case on such terms and conditions as deemed just and proper by the court in seisin of the case with further condition that they will not indulge themselves in commission of similar activity.

Violation of any of the above condition(s) shall entail cancellation of bail.

5. The BLAPL is accordingly disposed of.
